IFA Reporting changes

The Improvement Foundation Australia (IFA) is undertaking a number of initiatives to improve data reporting. One of these is the implementation of a Web Based Reporting Tool (WBRT). This new portal will accept data for APCC, QAIHC and now also Healthy For Life Reporting. Other reports will be added in due course.

Practices which have been submitting APCC data to the IFA will notice a few changes within CAT to facilitate the transition to the new portal and to accept a number of different reports. The IFA will

be sending out advice to users via their mailing list.

Healthy For Life Reporting

The Healthy For Life (HFL) Report has been upgraded to Version 5 of the specifications. It has been rewritten for CAT so that it can be made available to all users where their data extract is at a minimum of version 1_6 which contains the appropriate data items.

The HFL Report can be submitted to the Improvement Foundation portal providing practices with an easier method of reporting and tools to monitor health outcomes.
