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Swine Flu Immunisation Report **CAT Version 2-7 Release**

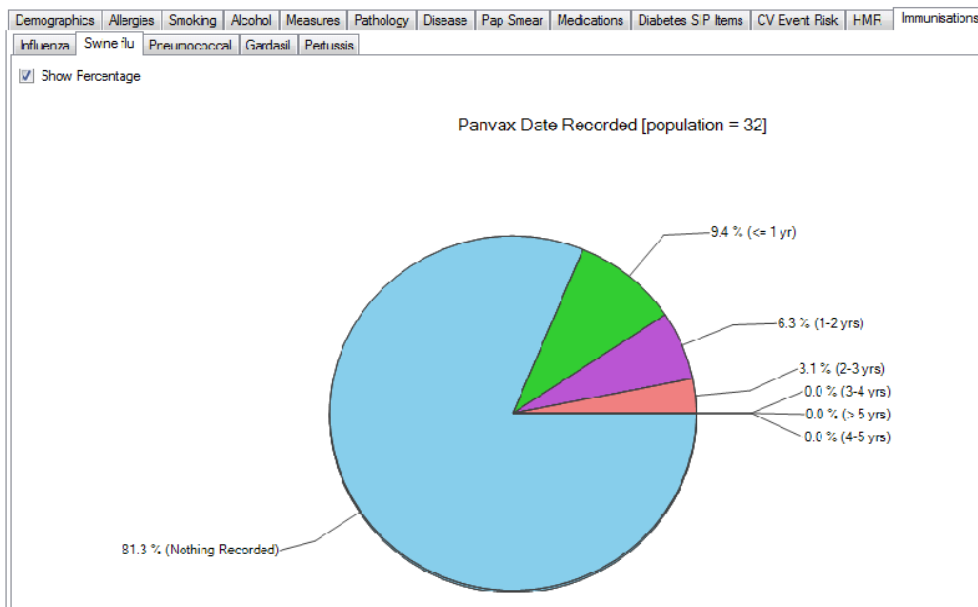
A new graph is provided under the Immunisations tab for Swine flu. This will collect the following immunisations:

- Panvax
- Panvax H1N1
- Pandemic (H1N1) Influenza
- Influenza Panvax

The graph reports on the date of the last recorded immunisation.

NEW APCC Indicators CAT Version 2-7 Release

The following conditions are now being collected and are used by the APCC Report.

CARDIOVASCULAR

- Peripheral Vascular Disease
- Carotid Stenosis
- Renal Artery Stenosis

NEW FILTERS: These conditions have been grouped as 'Other' under the existing Cardiovascular heading.



RENAL

- Chronic Renal Failure

NEW FILTERS: This condition has been listed under the new heading 'Renal' which also includes the existing condition 'Renal Impairment'.

Please refer to the [User Guide Appendices](#) for a list of Medical Director diagnosis codes that map to this condition.

Please Note: The updated APCC report is initially available to MD users only.

The following updates have been made to the APCC Report

- COPD-008 has been removed
- General section has been renamed Prevention
- GEN-001 to GEN-006 have been updated to apply to patients >= 18 years age
- New Prevention indicators GEN-009 to GEN-019 have been added

A Prevention indicators manual entry form has been added for indicators where the numerator cannot be collected.
